



# CHRISTLESS CHRISTIANITY

"Christless Christianity sounds contradictory but it exists as a real phenomenon in our day. Much that is being done in Christ's name is false to Christ in that it is conceived by the flesh, incorporates fleshly methods, and seeks fleshly ends. Christ is mentioned from time to time in the same way and for the same reason that a self-seeking politician mentions Lincoln and the flag, to provide a sacred front for carnal activities and to deceive the simplehearted listeners. This giveaway is that Christ is not central: He is not all and in all." -A. W. Tozer

Christ is not denied but trivialized, used for our purposes rather than received, obeyed, worshiped, and enjoyed. But Jesus Christ is the center and circumference of Christianity. But sadly, there are those who lay claim to Christianity without Christ. Jesus plainly stated "I am the way, the truth, and the life No man comes to the Father except through Me." (Jn. 14: 6). In spite of this there are those who claim that one can come to God, and be saved, and not even believe in Christ. On the other hand, there are those who claim to believe in Christ, but do not think they have to listen to, and obey Him. But Matt. 17: 5 clearly says that God's voice, speaking from heaven said: "This is My Beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!" The writer of Hebrews said "And having been perfected. He (Christ) became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him" (Heb. 5: 9). Last, Jesus said, "Why do you call Me Lord, Lord, and do not do the things which I say" (Lk. 6: 46). Newsweek reported churches, "have developed a pick and choose Christianity in which individuals take what they want...and pass over what does not fit their goals. What many have left behind is a pervasive view of sin." Such might be labeled "Christianity-light."

Joel Osteen, said, "I'm not sure what happens to people who reject Christ." Larry King, on CNN asked: "They're wrong aren't they?" Osteen replied, "Well, I don't know if I believe they're wrong." King also asked Joel Osteen, "Is it hard to lead a Christian life?" Osteen said: "I'm not trying to follow a set of rules and stuff. I'm just living my life."

Clearly, the way to God is through His Son Jesus Christ. He cannot be by-passed, nor is there a detour around Him. Christless Christianity, or Christianity-light does not lead one to Heaven.
