JESUS IS VICTORIOUS OVER SATAN

In Christ Jesus alone there is victory. On the cross of calvary Jesus purchased our salvation and redemption, but He also accomplished something else.

He defeated Satan:

"He [Jesus] disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them Him" (Col. 2:15).

Satan is a powerful and cunning enemy and has deceived many (Gen. 3,4, Jn. 8:44). But Christ defeated him and even put him and the rulers and authorities to open shame through His death on the cross (Col. 2:15; 1 Pet. 3:22). Jesus was victorious.

Jesus then arose from the dead because death's power could not contain Him (Eph. 1:20; Rev. 1:18).

Jesus personally conquered the devil and death and became "the firstborn from the dead" (Col. 1:18). He now has sole proprietorship and ownership of all things because "by Him all things were created in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible" (Col. 1:16).

He crushed the devil's head by His death and resurrection (Gen. 3:15).

What Does Jesus' Victory Mean for Us?

His victory over Satan means everything for us spiritually. One major thing is that His kingdom was established after He entered into His glory (Acts 2:14-47; Jn. 7:39; Col. 1:13-14).

In His spiritual kingdom we have complete fellowship with God and complete remission of our sins (Col. 1:14; Eph. 1:7). There is no partial remission of sins in Jesus (Rom. 8:1). If you are in Christ, God is not waiting to trap you on Judgement Day by hanging your old sins over your head. As you remain in Him, your sins are completely forgiven (Heb. 8:12-13).

But wait, there is more...

"The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you" (Rom. 16:20).

The Holy Spirit is speaking about the saints in this passage. God promises that He will crush Satan under our feet as well. We partake of the victory of Jesus' defeat of the devil.

"No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death nor life nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth nor anything else in all creation will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus" (Rom. 8:37-39).

The saints overcome the devil with the blood of the lamb (Rev. 12:11)

Due to Jesus shedding His blood on the cross establishing His kingdom we can be freed from the bondage of sin (Rom. 6).

Would you like to attain this victory? Follow Jesus! Obey His words. Jesus says "He who believes and is baptized shall be saved, he who disbelieves shall be condemned" (Mk. 16:16). He says repent or perish (Lk. 13:3). He also says "be faithful unto death and I will give you a crown of life" (Rev. 2:10).

Jesus also says that the one who does the will of His Father will enter heaven (Matt. 7:21). God's will is found in His word (2 Tim. 3:16). Are you seeking to obey the Father's will in all things? If not, why not? Do not delay! Why not obey Him today and attain victory over Satan?
