

2. Believe in Christ (John 8:24; 20:31; Heb 11:6)
3. Repent of all sins (Luke 13:3; Acts 17:30; Rom 2:4; 2 Cor 7:9,10)
4. Confess faith in Christ (Rom 10:10; Acts 17:30; Matt 16:16)
5. Be baptized into Christ for remission of sins (Acts 2:38; 22:16)
6. Live faithfully (Revelation 2:10)

### 7 THINGS TO REMEMBER DURING THE LORD'S SUPPER!

- 1 LORD. "There is one Lord." (Ephesians 4:5)
- 2 THIEVES. "There were also 2 others, criminals, led with Him to be put to death."  
(Luke 23:32)
- 3 CROSSES. (Luke 23:39-43; Ephesians 1:7)
- 4 PARTS of HIS GARMENTS. "Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His garments and made four parts, to each soldier, a part, and also the tunic." (John 19:23)
- 5 WOUNDS. His head was crowned with thorns. His back was scourged.  
His side was cut open. His hands were pierced. His feet were pierced. (John 19:20)
- 6 HOURS of AGONY. Christ was crucified at the 3rd hour and died at the 9th hour.  
(Mark 15:25-37)

# SALVATION: WHERE, HOW, AND WHEN?

The gospel is all about salvation. The apostle Paul writes, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek" (Rom. 1:16, NKJV). Salvation is needed by all because "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (3:23).

While many people acknowledge that Jesus Christ offers salvation from sin, and while many recognize that salvation is vitally important, few understand what the Bible teaches concerning where, how, and when salvation is obtained by sinners. Please consider the answers provided in the New Testament concerning where, how, and when salvation may be received.

1. Where? Speaking of Jesus, Paul writes, "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace" (Eph. 1:7). Salvation is found only in Christ. The apostle John writes, "And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life" (1 Jn. 5:11-12). For those who have transgressed the will of God, there is no salvation outside of Christ. The only sinners who receive eternal salvation are those who enter into a relationship with Jesus Christ.

2. How? Paul wrote to the Colossian Christians concerning what was accomplished through the sacrifice of Christ, saying, "For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell, and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross. And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight" (Col. 1:19-22). Salvation would not be possible were it not for the sacrifice of the Son of God. Paul writes, "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him" (Rom. 5:8-9). The only sinners who receive eternal salvation are those who are cleansed by the blood of Christ.

3. When? Since salvation is available through the blood of Christ, and is found in Christ, when does a sinner receive it? To the churches of Galatia, Paul writes, "For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ" (Gal. 3:26-27). One enters into Christ by faith when he is baptized into Christ. "Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life" (Rom. 6:3-4). The only sinners who receive eternal salvation are those who enter into a relationship with Jesus Christ, being cleansed by His blood, when they are baptized into Christ.

## Conclusion

The Bible answers the question of where, how, and when salvation is received by sinners. Each one must come to the Lord on His terms in order to be freed from the guilt of sin. The Bible says, "And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him" (Heb. 5:9). Will you obey the Lord?
